Dear Gerry,

We welcome the opportunity to comment on ORR's proposed modification to the National Station Access Conditions 2013 (England & Wales) and National Station Access Conditions 2013 (Scotland), together the 'NSACs', to rectify a cross-referencing error that resulted from the PR13 review notice for stations.

Network Rail supports the proposal to correct the cross-referencing error in Condition F11.2.1 (ii) of the NSACs as highlighted in the modification letter of 8 May 2014, specifically that the current reference to reviewing the long term charge as a result of any review notice given by ORR "*under paragraph 42.4.1.2*" is incorrect. We agree that the cross reference should be amended to "*Condition F11.4.1.2*" and that the test set out in Condition B6 of the NSACs has been met to make this change.
