## **ORR consultation on Connection contracts**

Dear Gordon

Go-Ahead Group is one of the leading rail and bus operators in the UK. We are a long established operator of rail franchises, and through our Govia subsidiary, which is a joint venture between the Go-Ahead Group (65%) and Keolis (35%). Govia has extensive experience running complex and challenging rail operations. Govia currently runs four major rail franchises: GTR, Southern, Southeastern and London Midland. Govia is the UK's busiest rail operator, currently providing around 35% of all passenger journeys.
