

## PROSECUTION

<b>Summary</b>	<p>On the 2 July 2011, one of ORR's Inspectors of Railways attended the site of a Network Rail construction project at River Gowy, near Chester as part of a routine visit.</p> <p>He observed a number of unsafe practises taking place in the vicinity of overhead power lines. Although the lack of precautions did not result in any injuries, the circumstances gave rise to a high risk of serious personal injury.</p>

<b>Breaches involved</b>	Regulation 4(3) of the Electricity at Work Regulations 1989
<b>Date(s) of offence</b>	30th September 2003
<b>Plea</b>	Guilty
<b>Result</b>	Barhale Construction plc were fined at Chester Magistrates' Court on 3 July 2013
<b>Penalty</b>	£13,000
<b>Costs</b>	£ 11,899
