Consultation on ORR's code of practice for applications made under section 16A of the Railways Act 1993

- 1. I am writing to consult you on a draft code of practice for applications made under section 16A of the Railways Act 1993.
- 2. The Railways Act 1993 was amended by the Transport Act 2000 to include sections 16A I. Theses additional sections enabled the Secretary of State (or a third party with his consent) to apply to ORR to give directions to a railway facility owner to improve or construct a new railway facility. Section 16H also placed ORR under an obligation to develop a code of practice for handling any section16A applications but sections 16A I were not commenced at that time.
- 3. The investment framework document of October 2005 stated that we would develop a code of practice for section 16A applications upon commencement of these sections and the Secretary of State made the commencement order for sections16A I in the same month.
