Plea	Guilty
Result	South West Trains Ltd pleaded guilty and were fined at Wimbledon Magistrates Court on 11 June 2010
Penalty	HSWA 1974 section 2 (1) = £10,000 Management regulations 1999 section 3 (1) = £5,000
