<b>Summary</b>	On 19 March 2006 a train struck two loaded wheelbarrows, which were left in the four foot, on the down mainline at Manor Park Station, and being used by contractors who were repointing brickwork outside of the possession. The train was not derailed and the contractors received only minor injuries.
