

Routes to Register of Recognised Psychological Practitioners

Must hold a British Psychological Society Certificate in Occupational Testing (Level A/ Level 2)

Holder of a Level A/Level 2 qualification gained via assessment conducted by a Chartered Psychologist registered with BPS

Applies to join ORR register

ORR application consists of:

Evidence of BPS Level A/2 qualification

Supply copy of certificate and declare awarding body/person

Evidence of being on the BPS register for psychological testing

Supply copy of letter from BPS that confirms this.

Appreciation of the specific nature of railway work and environment

Demonstrated by either

Current employment in assessment centre which has passed an external audit in line with ATOC CoP and evidence of knowledge of the train driver competency framework

or
Evidence to demonstrate suitability to carry out testing for train driver recruitment and knowledge of the train driver competency framework

Declaration on assessment tools to be used

Carrying out suite of tests as recommended by RSSB RIS- 3751-TOM

Carrying out an alternative set of occupational psychometric tests which have been reviewed by BPS and meet either same or better standard than those recommended in RSSB RIS-3751-TOM

ORR seeks independent assessment of evidence of validity of suite of tests proposed for use

Registered practitioners will be asked if they still undertake tests every five years

Must carry out tests which adhere to psychological-scientific principles and meet the criteria for understanding the railway environment
