74th Supplemental Agreement

between

NETWORK RAIL INFRASTRUCTURE LIMITED

as Network Rail

and

FIRST GREATER WESTERN LIMITED

as Train Operator

relating to the Track Access Contract (Passenger Services) dated 8th December 2006

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THIS 74TH SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT is dated 25 January 2012 and made

BETWEEN:

- (1) <u>NETWORK RAIL INFRASTRUCTURE LIMITED</u>, a company registered in England under number 2904587 having its registered office at Kings Place, 90 York Way, London, N1 9AG ("Network Rail"); and"
- (2) <u>FIRST GREATER WESTERN LIMITED</u>, (the "Train Operator"), a company registered in England under number 05113733 having its registered office at Milford House, 1 Milford Street, Swindon SN1 1HL.

WHEREAS:

- (A) The parties entered into a Track Access Contract (Passenger Services) dated 8th December 2006 on terms approved, and pursuant to directions issued, by ORR under section 18 of the Act which has been amended by various Supplemental Agreements, each in a form approved by ORR pursuant to section 22 of the Act (the "Contract").
- (B) The parties propose to enter into this Supplemental Agreement in order to add Class 150 to Specified Equipment for Reading Basingstoke services.

IT IS HEREBY AGREED as follows:

1 INTERPRETATION

In this Supplemental Agreement, unless the context otherwise requires:

Words and phrases defined in, and rules of interpretation set out in, the Contract shall have the same meaning and effect when used in this Supplemental Agreement; and

"Effective Date" means the date on which this document is signed.

2 EFFECTIVE DATE AND TERM

The amendments made to the Contract shall have effect from the Effective Date and shall cease to have effect at 01:59 hours on the Expiry Date or earlier termination of the Contract.

3 ORR - GENERAL APPROVAL

This Supplemental Agreement is entered into pursuant to the Passenger Access (Short Term Timetable and Miscellaneous Changes) General Approval 2009.

4 AMENDMENTS TO THE CONTRACT

- 4.1 Schedule 5 shall be amended through
 - 4.1.1 The deletion of the current Table 5.1 Specified Equipment as it applies to EF07
 - 4.1.2 The insertion of new Table 5.1 Specified Equipment as it applies to EF07
- 4.2 Schedule 7 shall be amended through
 - 4.2.1 The deletion of the current Appendix 7C
 - 4.2.2 The insertion of a new Appendix 7C

5 GENERAL

The parties agree that the Contract, as amended by this Supplemental Agreement, shall remain in full force and effect in accordance with its terms, and during the period in which the amendments made by this Supplemental Agreement are to have effect, all references in the Contract to "the contract" or, as the case may be, the "Agreement", "herein", "hereof", "hereunder" and other similar expressions shall, unless the context requires otherwise, be read and construed as a reference to the Contract as amended by this Supplemental Agreement.

6 THIRD PARTY RIGHTS

No person who is not a party to this Supplemental Agreement shall have any right under the Contracts (Rights of Third Parties) Act 1999 to enforce any term of this Supplemental Agreement.

7 LAW

This Supplemental Agreement shall be governed by, construed and given effect to in all respects in accordance with English Law.

8 COUNTERPARTS

This Supplemental Agreement may be executed in two counterparts which, taken together, shall constitute one and the same document. Either party may enter into this Supplemental Agreement by signing either of such counterparts.
