


Supplier Code of Conduct

Context

Introduction

Suppliers are expected to minimise their environmental impact and promote sustainability.

This includes:

- Reducing waste and emissions
- Using resources efficiently
- Complying with environmental regulations and standards

Transparency and Accountability

Suppliers must maintain transparency in their operations and be accountable for their actions.

This includes:

Providing accurate and timely information to ORR

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- Cooperating with audits and inspections
- Reporting any violations of this Code of Conduct

Social Responsibility

Suppliers are encouraged to contribute positively to the communities in which they operate.

This includes:

- Supporting local employment and economic development
- Engaging in charitable activities and community initiatives

Data Protection and Privacy

Suppliers must comply with all applicable data protection laws, including the UK General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR).

This includes:

 Ensuring the confidentiality, integrity, and availability of all data provided by ORR

Innovation and Collaboration

This includes:

• Fostering a collaborative relationship with ORR to achieve mutual goals

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Risk Management

Suppliers must implement robust risk management processes to identify, assess, and mitigate potential risks.

This includes:

 Ensuring business continuity plans are in place to address any disruptions where appropriate.

Monitoring and Enforcement
