AMENDMENTS TO THE SEPTEMBER 2020 DELAY ATTRIBUTION PRINCIPLES AND RULES

published in the DAPR until the Delay Attribution Board is satisfied that Train Operators are no longer utilising the Passenger Charter.

The following parts of Proposal NR P205 may only take effect upon removal of the Passenger Charter and may not be published in the DAPR until the Delay Attribution Board is satisfied that Train Operators are no longer utilising the Passenger Charter:

- removal of Delay Code X3 from Section S of the DAPR;
- the amendment of all entries of "X3" in the DAPR to read "J6";
- the amendment of Delay Code J6 Description and Abbreviation;
- the removal of Delay Code X8 from Section S of the DAPR;
- the amendment of all entries of "X8" in the DAPR to read "I8"; and
- the amendment of Delay Code I8 Description and Abbreviation.
