Approval of the 23rd supplemental agreement to the track access contract between Network Rail Infrastructure Limited and Abellio ScotRail Limited dated 3 March 2016

We have today approved the above supplemental agreement submitted to us formally on 18 November 2020 under section 22 of the Railways Act 1993 (the Act). This follows an earlier informal submission of a draft agreement for our consideration. This letter explains the reasons for our decision.

Purpose

The purpose of this agreement is to grant Abellio ScotRail the rights necessary to operate the service between Dunbar and Edinburgh Waverley/Haymarket formerly operated by Cross Country Trains. There are also some reductions in contingent rights elsewhere in service group HA02, and a rewrite of service group HA08 to reflect the new timetable proposals. The rights are to commence on the Principal Change Date 2020 and will expire on the Expiry Date or earlier termination of Abellio ScotRail's track access contract.

Industry consultation

Network Rail undertook the usual industry consultation. No comments or queries were received.

ORR review

Our review of the application raised no operational, performance or economic concerns. We identified some minor drafting issues and these were resolved when the agreement was formally submitted.

Our duties under section 4 of the Act and our decision

We have concluded that approval of this supplemental agreement strikes the appropriate balance in discharging our statutory duties under section 4 of the Act; in particular, those relating to protecting the interests of users of railway services (section 4(1)(a)), promoting the use of the railway network for the carriage of passengers (section 4(1)(b)) and enabling persons providing railway services to plan their businesses with a reasonable degree of assurance (section 4(1)(g)).

Conformed copy of the track access agreement

Under clause 18.2.4 of the track access contract, Network Rail is required to produce a conformed copy, within 28 days of any amendment being made, and send copies to ORR and the Train Operator. Please send the conformed copy to me at ORR.
