Approval of the Thirty Second Supplemental Agreement to the Track Access Contract between Network Rail Infrastructure Limited and Northern Trains Limited

The Office of Rail and Road (ORR) has today approved the Thirty Second Supplemental Agreement to the Track Access Contract (TAC) dated 3 March 2016 between Network Rail Infrastructure Limited (Network Rail) and Northern Trains Limited (Northern) (jointly the parties).

Purpose of the agreement and background

On 1st March 2020, the rights and obligations of Arriva Rail North Limited under the TAC were transferred to Northern Trains Limited (NTL) pursuant to a transfer scheme made by the Secretary of State for Transport under Schedule 2 of the Railways Act 2005.

The purpose of this agreement is to update a number of details in the Contract to reflect the transfer that occurred in March 2020. This includes inserting 'NTL' in place of 'ARN', and "Services Agreement" in place of "Franchise Agreement".

ORR review and conclusions

We reviewed the agreement and noted that the changes introduced reflect the effect of the DfT transfer scheme. We also note that no industry consultation was required as the changes do not have a material impact on the access rights held.
