Approval of the 84th supplemental agreement to the track access contract between Network Rail Infrastructure Limited and London & South Eastern Railway Limited dated 6 December 2007

We have today approved the above supplemental agreement submitted to us formally on 26 January 2022 under section 22 of the Railways Act 1993 (the Act). This follows an earlier informal submission of a draft agreement for our consideration. This letter explains the reasons for our decision.

Purpose

The purpose of this agreement is to amend Annex B to Part 3 of Schedule 4 of the track access contract. The contract was transferred by way of a Statutory Transfer Scheme from London & South Eastern Railway Limited to SE Trains Limited on 17 October 2021.

The amendments are needed to ensure they reflect current services.

An industry consultation was not necessary as these changes do not affect any other party.

Our review of the application raised no concerns.

Our duties under section 4 of the Act and our decision

We have concluded that approval of this supplemental agreement strikes the appropriate balance in discharging our statutory duties under section 4 of the Act; in particular, those relating to protecting the interests of users of railway services (section 4(1)(a)), promoting the use of the railway network for the carriage of passengers (section 4(1)(b)) and enabling persons providing railway services to plan their businesses with a reasonable degree of assurance (section 4(1)(g)).
