Approval of the 88th supplemental agreement to the track access contract between Network Rail Infrastructure Limited and Abellio East Anglia Limited dated 10 December 2004

We have today approved the above supplemental agreement submitted to us formally on 17 March 2022 under section 22 of the Railways Act 1993 (the Act). This follows an earlier informal submission of a draft agreement for our consideration. This letter explains the reasons for our decision.

Purpose

The purpose of this agreement is to extend Abellio East Anglia Limited's track access rights from Principal Change Date 2022 to Principal Change Date 2024.

Industry consultation

Network Rail undertook the usual industry consultation between 11 January to 11 February 2022. Cross Country confirmed it's support and Great Western Railway said it had no objections. Transport also Focus confirmed it supported the change. Network Rail provided us with confirmation of DfT's response.

We have no outstanding consultation issues.

We have concluded that approval of this supplemental agreement strikes the appropriate balance in discharging our statutory duties under section 4 of the Act; in particular, those relating to protecting the interests of users of railway services (section 4(1)(a)), promoting the use of the railway network for the carriage of passengers (section 4(1)(b)) and enabling persons providing railway services to plan their businesses with a reasonable degree of assurance (section 4(1)(g)).
