Approval of the 4th supplemental agreement to the track access contract between Amey Keolis Infrastructure / Seilwaith Amey Keolis Limited (CVL IM) and Transport for Wales Limited (TfW)

We have today approved the above supplemental agreement submitted to us formally on 17 August under section 22 of the Railways Act 1993 (the Act). This follows an earlier informal submission of a draft agreement for our consideration. This letter explains the reasons for our decision.

#### **Purpose**

The purpose of this agreement is to remove references to the Class 142 vehicles from Schedule 5, as these vehicles are no longer being used on the CVL network. It also amends Paragraph 1 of Schedule 1 to correct an error in the name of the infrastructure manager.

# **Industry consultation**

Network Rail undertook the normal industry consultation for 1 month from 8 June. No concerns or objections were raised.

#### **ORR** review

Our review of the application raised no economic, operational or drafting concerns.

#### Our duties under section 4 of the Act and our decision

We have concluded that approval of this supplemental agreement strikes the appropriate balance in discharging our statutory duties under section 4 of the Act; in particular, those relating to protecting the interests of users of railway services (section 4(1)(a)), promoting the use of the railway network for the carriage of passengers (section 4(1)(b)) and enabling persons providing railway services to plan their businesses with a reasonable degree of assurance (section 4(1)(g)).
