Approval of the 47th supplemental agreement to the track access contract between Network Rail Infrastructure Limited and Govia Thameslink Railway Limited dated 2 March 2016

We have today approved the above supplemental agreement submitted to us formally on 26 August 2022 under section 22 of the Railways Act 1993 (the Act). This follows an earlier informal submission of a draft agreement for our consideration. This letter explains the reasons for our decision.

Purpose

The purpose of this agreement is to make the amendments necessary to Govia Thameslink Railway's (GTR) track access contract to put in place all the access rights needed for its September 2022 timetable. Some existing rights will be removed completely and a number of rights for new services will be added in service groups ET08 and ET09. All amendments will run until the end of the track access contract in May 2024.

Industry consultation

Network Rail undertook the usual industry consultation from 22 July 2022 to 22 August 2022. No concerns or objections were raised.

ORR review

ORR has reviewed this application. We had no operational concerns. There was a mismatch between the information in the Form P and the supplemental agreement but this was corrected during the consultation.

Our duties under section 4 of the Act and our decision

We have concluded that approval of this supplemental agreement strikes the appropriate balance in discharging our statutory duties under section 4 of the Act; in particular, those relating to protecting the interests of users of railway services (section 4(1)(a)), promoting the use of the railway network for the carriage of passengers (section 4(1)(b)) and enabling persons providing railway services to plan their businesses with a reasonable degree of assurance (section 4(1)(g)).

Conformed copy of the track access agreement

Under clause 18.2.4 of the track access contract, Network Rail is required to produce a conformed copy, within 28 days of any amendment being made, and send copies to ORR and the Train Operator. Please send the conformed copy to me at ORR.
