APPROVAL OF PROPOSAL FOR CHANGE TO THE CROSSRAIL CENTRAL OPERATING SECTION (CCOS) NETWORK CODE

- 1. The Office of Rail and Road (ORR) has today approved a Proposal for Change (PfC) to the CCOS Network Code, which was submitted to it by Rail for London Infrastructure Limited (RfL(I)) on 13 March 2023.
- 2. This proposal amends Part C of the CCOS Network Code to streamline the process for making modifications to the Code where changes are reasonably necessary as a result of modifications to the Network Rail Network Code, or where RfL(I) receives no material written representations in respect of a CCOS PfC from consultees during the Consultation Period.
- 3. ORR has reviewed the consultation responses received, which were supportive of the proposal. ORR responded to the consultation with some suggested modifications, which have been adopted.
- 4. The approval of the PfC is consistent with ORR's section 4 duties.
- 5. In accordance with Condition C2.5 of the CCOS Network Code, the amendments shall have effect 14 days from the date of this notification.
- 6. In giving RfL(I) notice of approval ORR also copies this letter and attached notice to all parties identified under Condition A4.1 of the CCOS Network Code.
- 7. A copy of this letter, the approval notice and a marked up copy of Part C of the CCOS Network Code, showing all the proposed changes, will be placed on the ORR website. A copy of the approval notice will also be placed on the ORR's public register.
