Approval of the 10th supplemental agreement to the track access contract between Network Rail Infrastructure Limited and Merseyrail Electrics 2002 Limited dated 1 April 2019

We have today approved the above supplemental agreement submitted to us formally on 3 July 2023 under section 22 of the Railways Act 1993 (the Act). This follows an earlier informal submission of a draft agreement for our consideration. This letter explains the reasons for our decision.

Purpose

The purpose of this agreement is to amend Appendix 1 to Schedule 8 to reflect the introduction of a new station at Headbolt Lane currently due to enter into service in September 2023 and Headbolt Lane to replace Kirkby as a monitoring point (reverse direction) at that time.

Industry consultation

No industry consultation was required as the changes do not affect any other party.

ORR review

Our review of the application raised no operational, performance or economic concerns.

We have concluded that approval of this supplemental agreement strikes the appropriate balance in discharging our statutory duties under section 4 of the Act; in particular, those relating to protecting the interests of users of railway services (section 4(1)(a)), promoting the use of the railway network for the carriage of passengers (section 4(1)(b)) and enabling persons providing railway services to plan their businesses with a reasonable degree of assurance (section 4(1)(g)).
