# Approval of the 54th supplemental agreement to the track access contract between Network Rail Infrastructure Limited and Govia Thameslink Railway Limited dated 2 March 2016

We have today approved the above supplemental agreement submitted to us formally on 17 August 2023 under section 22 of the Railways Act 1993 (the Act). This follows an earlier informal submission of a draft agreement for our consideration. This letter explains the reasons for our decision.

# Purpose

Govia Thameslink Railway Limited (GTR) extended weekday and Saturday services between Bedford and Gatwick to Three Bridges in December 2022. These extensions are covered under contingent rights which are due to expire on 21 August 2023. The purpose of this agreement is to provide firm rights to cover the extended portion of these services, between Gatwick and Three Bridges, in both directions.

#### Industry consultation

Network Rail carried out the standard industry consultation in June and July 2023. No issues were raised by any consultees.

# **ORR** review

Our review of the application raised no operational, performance or economic concerns.

We have concluded that approval of this supplemental agreement strikes the appropriate balance in discharging our statutory duties under section 4 of the Act; in particular, those relating to protecting the interests of users of railway services (section 4(1)(a)), promoting the use of the railway network for the carriage of passengers (section 4(1)(b)) and enabling persons providing railway services to plan their businesses with a reasonable degree of assurance (section 4(1)(g)).
