Consent to supplement the track usage price list (Class 777) following a joint proposal by Network Rail Infrastructure Limited (Network Rail) and West Midlands Trains Limited (WMT)

We have today consented to supplement the track usage price list, following a joint proposal submitted to us by the above on 1 March 2024, under paragraph 9 of Part 2 of schedule 7 to their track access contract [TAC]. The change shall have effect from the date on which the vehicles were first used on the network by the train operator.

Proposal

The purpose of this supplement is to amend the Passenger Variable Usage Charge (VUC) Rates section of the Track Usage Price List to include new Class 350 Motor (350HB/1/M, 350HB/3/4/M) and Trailer (350HB/1/T, 350/3/4/T) vehicle types. They have been operating on the network since 30 August 2023.
