

LEVEL CROSSINGS ACT 1983
THE NETWORK RAIL
WATERLOO LEVEL CROSSING
REVOCATION ORDER 2021

Made on 10 January 2022

Coming into force on 21 January 2022

The Secretary of State for Transport, having been requested by Network Rail Infrastructure Limited (“the operator”) to make an Order under Section 1(5) of the Level Crossings Act 1983^(a) (“the Act”) makes the following Order in exercise of his powers under the Act and of all other enabling powers, in accordance with the draft Order which accompanied the request subject to those modifications the Secretary of State thought fit to make.

1. This Order may be cited as the Network Rail Waterloo Level Crossing Revocation Order 2021 and shall come into force on 21 January 2022.
2. The British Railways Board (Staines Wokingham and Woking Railway) (Waterloo Level Crossing) Order 1965 and The British Railways Board (Staines Wokingham and Woking Railway) (Waterloo Level Crossing) (Amendment No.7) Order 1993 are revoked.
