Dear Louise

GTR have reviewed Network Rails representations on both our 62nd and 63rd Supplementals. We have the following comments:

62nd Supplemental

GTR note that within their representation letter, Network Rail advise that they are unable to support any access rights requested in the 62nd Supplemental which have already received ORR approval in a subsequent application (in this instance, in the 65th Supplemental). To that end, we agree with Network Rail's approach that these access rights do not need to be considered within this 62nd supplemental.

GTR also note that Network Rail support the conversion of all existing Contingent rights (those not supported utilising the interim approach) to Firm rights.

63rd Supplemental

GTR notes that Network Rail acknowledges a S22A supplemental will be submitted very shortly for the remaining access rights required to facilitate the ECML timetable. The access rights detailed within their table concur with the rights we intend to include within our 70th Supplemental.
