THIS 42<sup>nd</sup> SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT is dated 14<sup>th</sup> November 2025 and made;  
BETWEEN

- (1) NETWORK RAIL INFRASTRUCTURE LIMITED, (“Network Rail”) a company registered in England under number 2904587, having its registered office at Waterloo General Office, London SE1 8SW; and
- (2) SOUTH WESTERN RAILWAY LIMITED, (the “Train Operator”) a company registered in England and Wales under number 03266760, having its registered office at South Bank Central, 4th Floor, 30 Stamford Street, London, SE1 9LQ.

WHEREAS:

(A) Network Rail and First MTR South Western Trains Limited entered into a Track Access Contract (Passenger Services) dated 9 April 2019, in a form approved by the Office of Rail and Road (ORR) pursuant to section 18(7) of the Act, as amended by various supplemental agreements, each in a form approved by ORR pursuant to section 22 of the Act (which track access contract as subsequently amended is hereafter referred to as the “Contract”).

(B) On 25 May 2025, the rights and obligations of First MTR South Western Trains Limited under the Contract were transferred to the Train Operator pursuant to a transfer scheme made by the Secretary of State for Transport under schedule 2 of the Railways Act 2005.

(C) The parties now proposed to enter into this Supplemental Agreement in order to amend the Contract as described herein.

IT IS HEREBY AGREED as follows:

## 1. INTERPRETATION

In this Supplemental Agreement, unless the context otherwise requires:

- (A) Words and expressions defined in, and rules of interpretation set out in the Contract shall have the same meaning and effect when used in this Supplemental Agreement except where the context requires otherwise.
- (B) “Effective Date” means 02:00 14<sup>th</sup> December 2025.

## 2. EFFECTIVE DATE AND TERM

The amendments made to the Contract as set out in this Supplemental Agreement shall have effect from the Effective Date and shall cease to have effect on the expiry or earlier termination of the Contract.

## 3. OFFICE OF RAIL AND ROAD GENERAL APPROVAL

This Supplemental Agreement is entered into pursuant to the Passenger Access (Short Term Timetable and Miscellaneous Changes) General Approval 2023.

#### 4. AMENDMENTS TO THE CONTRACT

From the Effective Date, Appendix 7C of Schedule 7 shall be deleted in its entirety and replaced by a new Appendix 1 as set out in Appendix A to this Supplemental Agreement.

#### 5. EFFECTS OF THIS SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT ON THE CONTRACT

The Contract, as amended by this Supplemental Agreement, shall remain in full force and effect in accordance with its terms, and during the period in which the amendments made by this Supplemental Agreement are to have effect all references in the Contract to “the contract”, “herein”, “hereof”, “hereunder” and other similar expressions shall, unless the context requires otherwise, be read and construed as a reference to the Contract as amended by this Supplemental Agreement.

#### 6. THIRD PARTY RIGHTS

No person who is not a party to this Supplemental Agreement shall have any right under the Contracts (Rights of Third Parties) Act 1999 to enforce any term of this Supplemental Agreement.

#### 7. LAW

This Supplemental Agreement shall be governed by, construed and given effect to in all respects in accordance with English Law.

#### 8. COUNTERPARTS

This Supplemental Agreement may be executed in two counterparts which, taken together, shall constitute one and the same document. Either party may enter into this Supplemental Agreement by signing either of such counterparts.
