- 4)o I will today send a copy of the closure ratification notice to the Department foro Transport, and to all the parties consulted by the Department for Transport. A copy of theo notice will also appear on the ORR website and will be placed on the ORR public register.
- 5)o In deciding whether to ratify this proposed closure, ORR has checked that theo Department for Transport has:o



- a) provided ORR with the appropriate documentation;
- b) followed the consultation requirements laid down in the Act, and by the Railways Closure Guidance issued by the Secretary of State on 18 October 2006;

## Closure Ratification Notice – Angel Road station

- 1. On 21 February 2019 the Department for Transport asked the Office of Rail and Road (ORR) to ratify the proposal to close Angel Road station.
- 2. Further to s32(8) of the Railways Act 2005 (the Act), I am satisfied that:
  - a) there has been no failure or defect in the consultation; and
  - b) the proposal satisfies the criteria set out in the relevant part of the closure guidance issued under the Act.
- 3. Having considered the overall proposal, I hereby ratify the closure of Angel Road station.
- 4. Under s33(2) of the Act, ORR may "impose such requirements relevant to the proposal as it considers appropriate". I do not consider it appropriate to impose such requirements in this case.
- 5. Under ORR's powers in s32(9)(b) of the Act, I require the operator of Angel Road station to display this notice at the station for a period of 4 weeks following the date of this notice.
- 6. In addition, I require the operators of the stations in the area affected by the closure Hertford East, Ware, St. Margarets, Rye House, Broxbourne, Cheshunt, Waltham Cross, Enfield Lock, Northumberland Park, Tottenham Hale, Lea Bridge, Bishop's Stortford, Sawbridgeworth, Stratford, Harlow Mill, Harlow Town, Roydon to display this notice at those stations for the same period.
