

PROSECUTION

Summary	Train operator London & Birmingham Railway Limited (London Midland) and construction company JSS Rail Limited (Sisk Rail) were prosecuted for breaches of health and safety law after failing to ensure public safety during the refurbishment of Berkhamstead station, Hertfordshire, in 2012, which led to a passenger being seriously injured after falling down a stairway.
