POSSESSIONS: BLOXWICH – HEDNESFORD & CHURCH FENTON – MILFORD JUNCTION – INFORMED TRAVELLER LICENCE CONDITION

1. Thank you for your letters of 12 October 2001 and 24 October 2001.

2. In light of the information you have provided, I am satisfied that the short notice possessions you are proposing, put Railtrack in breach of its Network Licence condition 9.2.(a).

3. However, I am satisfied that under section 55(5)(a) of the Railways Act 1993 the Regulator's section 4 duties would preclude his making a provisional or final enforcement order. This is because:

- (a) in the case of the Bloxwich Hednesford possessions, the cause of the short notice was outwith your control and involved a project of national importance; and
- (b) in the case of Church Fenton Milford Junction possession, the cause of the short notice relates to supply difficulties with switch and crossing rails, again outwith your control.

Accordingly, you should treat this letter as a notice for the purposes of section 55(6) of the Railways Act 1993. A copy of this letter will be placed on the Regulator's public register.
