**Notice of statutory consultation on changes to licence and SNRP conditions:
RSSB membership, safety and standards and Disabled People's Protection Policies**

ORR hereby gives notice under Section 12(2) of the Railways Act 1993, and Regulation 13(2) of the Railway (Licensing of Railway Undertakings) Regulations 2005, of its proposals to modify licence and Statement of National Regulatory Provisions ("SNRP") conditions for the licence and SNRP holders listed in the Annexes to this notice.

Effect of and reasons for Proposed Modifications

RSSB Membership and safety and standards

In connection with our 2018 periodic review of Network Rail's outputs and funding ("PR18"), we have consulted on the changes we propose to make to Network Rail's network licence at the start of control period 6 ("CP6"), on 1 April 2019. Some of the conditions we are changing also appear in licences for operators of trains², stations, light maintenance depots and other networks.

At the beginning of February, I wrote to holders of licences and SNRPs about the consequential changes that we propose to make to two licence and SNRP conditions.³ These relate to the membership of the Rail Safety and Standards Board ("RSSB") (Condition 8) and safety and standards; currently headed Railway Group Standards (usually Condition 9).

With regard to RSSB, in the same way that we are changing Network Rail's network licence, following consideration in our PR18 process, we propose to continue to require the licence or

SNRP holder to be a member of RSSB, but to modify the condition to reflect that it may discontinue membership with ORR's approval. The effect of this modification would be that they could, with ORR's approval, cease RSSB membership without being in conflict with their obligations. This aligns with the provisions in RSSB's constitution, which allows members to leave in some circumstances.

With regard to safety and standards, as with Network Rail's network licence we propose to modify the condition to require the licence or SNRP holder to comply with applicable Rail Industry Standards or to consult with affected parties where it proposes to depart from a Rail Industry Standard (in full or in part) and to deploy equally effective means of achieving its purpose. We also propose to modify the condition heading to reflect the broader coverage of the condition.

The effect of this modification would be that Rail Industry Standards are recognised in addition to Railway Group Standards, but that there is the potential to depart from their content in particular cases. This was developed with the support of RSSB's Industry Standards Coordination Committee to recognise the introduction of Rail Industry Standards, which define functional or technical requirements for railway compliance where there is no application of Railway Group Standards.

We propose to make this modification with the intention of reflecting the development of the railway technical standards regime since this condition was first put into place, clarifying the status of Rail Industry Standards as accepted best practice and more accurately reflecting the licence/SNRP holder's safety management duties to identify and apply a broader range of relevant technical and operational standards than just Railway Group Standards.

In my letter of 1 February, I said that we intended to proceed to formal statutory consultation, subject to any views received, in the second half of February. We have received no responses and therefore are proceeding with our proposals.

Our proposed changes to the existing text in licences and SNRPs are shown in red at Annex A and Annex B, with the changes in an Annex applying to the licence/SNRP holders listed in the that Annex. We currently intend that the modifications would take effect on 1 April 2019.

Disabled People's Protection Policy

We also proposed in our consultation of 14 November 2018, *Improving Assisted Travel*,⁴ to change the *Disabled People's Protection Policy*⁵ ("DPPP") condition in licences and SNRPs so that these terms are no longer used. We suggested two options, *Inclusive Travel Policy* and *Accessible Travel Policy*, and asked for views. Where they expressed a preference, responses to the consultation from licence/SNRP holders were almost entirely in favour of *Accessible Travel Policy*. Only one was not in favour.

As a result of this we propose to modify the conditions of licences/SNRPs to replace the terms "Disabled People's Protection Policy" and "DPPP" with "Accessible Travel Policy" and "ATP".

We consider that this change will reflect today's focus on accessible and inclusive services and also reflects the expectation of stakeholders as a better way of communicating the nature and purpose of the policy.

The effect of this amendment is to change the terminology used in the licence/SNRP. Separately, we propose that when licence holders submit their revised policies they are retitled *Accessible Travel Policy*, in line with the submission schedule to be provided at the publication of the final revised Guidance for Operators. This is intended to ensure consistent use of the new terminology.

The changes to the licence/SNRP conditions are set out at Annex C, with the changes applying to the licence/SNRP holders listed in that Annex. We currently intend that the modifications would take effect on 1 April 2019.

Proposed Modifications

Having gained views from stakeholders on all three of these proposed changes, we consider that these modifications should be made for the reasons set out above and that the change should be made for all licence/SNRP holders which are subject to the relevant conditions.



Annex A: Proposed Modification relating to RSSB Membership

We propose to make the changes shown in red to the current text below:

Condition 8: RSSB membership

1. If the [SNRP or licence] holder's annual turnover has never exceeded £1 million and the [SNRP or licence] holder is not a franchise operator, paragraphs 2 and 3 shall not have effect until the [SNRP or licence] holder's annual turnover exceeds £1 million for the first time. The [SNRP or licence] holder shall provide ORR with such information in respect of its annual turnover as ORR may from time to time require.
2. With effect from the date of the coming into force of this [SNRP or licence], **except where ORR consents otherwise**, the [SNRP or licence] holder shall:
 - (a) become and thereafter remain a member of RSSB;
 - (b) comply with its obligations under the Constitution Agreement and the articles of association of RSSB; **and**
 - (c) exercise its rights under the Constitution Agreement and the articles of association of RSSB so as to ensure that RSSB shall act in accordance with the Constitution Agreement. ~~and (d)~~
3. **With effect from the date of the coming into force of this [SNRP or licence], the [SNRP or licence] holder shall** comply with the Railway Group Standards Code prepared by RSSB.
4. When [a SNRP or licence] holder first becomes subject to the obligations in paragraphs 2 and 3 his rights, obligations and liabilities associated with such membership shall commence on the same day, and the [SNRP or licence] holder shall complete the formal and legal documentation associated with such membership within three months of that date.
5. In this condition:

“franchise operator”	includes an operator of last resort, under section 30 of the Act.

Annex B: Proposed Modification relating to safety and standards

We propose to make the changes shown in red to the current text below:

Condition [9 or 7]: ~~Railway Group Standards~~ Safety and standards

1. The [SNRP or licence] holder shall comply with:
 - (a) ~~thesuch~~ Railway Group Standards **as are** applicable to its licensed activities~~;~~ **and**
 - (b) **subject to paragraph 2, such Rail Industry Standards (or parts thereof) as are applicable to its licensed activities.**
2. **The [SNRP or licence] holder is not required to comply with an applicable Rail Industry Standard (or part thereof) where:**
 - (a) **it has, following consultation with such persons as it considers are likely to be affected, identified an equally effective measure which will achieve the purpose of the standard; and**
 - (b) **it has adopted and is complying with that measure.**

3. In this Condition:

“Railway Group Standards” means standards authorised pursuant to the Railway Group Standards Code prepared by RSSB; **and**

“Rail Industry Standards” **has the meaning set out in the Standards Manual, established by RSSB.**
