

## RAIB recommendation status category descriptions

<b>Implemented</b>	All actions to deliver a recommendation have been completed.
<b>Implemented by alternative means</b>	The risk associated with a recommendation has been addressed by alternative means. If the recommendation has been delivered by alternative means then this should be clearly stated in the ORR decision.
<b>Implementation ongoing</b>	ORR is <b>content with the proposed action plan</b> to implement the recommendation <b>and the timescale for delivery</b> that has been presented by the end implementer. This timescale should be recorded in the ORR decision.
<b>Insufficient response</b>	<p>Either:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• the end implementer has failed to provide a response; or</li> <li>• has provided a response that does not adequately satisfy ORR that sufficient action is being taken to properly consider and address a recommendation.</li> </ul> <p>The ORR decision should clearly explain the reasons for this categorisation.</p>
<b>Progressing</b>	<p>ORR is satisfied that the end implementer is taking suitable action to consider and address a recommendation, but the proposed solutions might be complex or required over a lengthy period of time. It may therefore not yet be possible to produce an accurate implementation plan to completion.</p> <p>The ORR decision should clearly explain the reasons for this categorisation.</p>

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<b>Non-Implementation</b>	<p>No action is proposed to deliver the recommendation. This status is only used when we are satisfied that:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• it is not appropriate to take any action to deliver the recommendation (including directing it to any person) and we can provide, without further dialogue with another party, a full explanation as to why no measures will be taken to implement the recommendation<sup>1</sup>;</li> <li>• we have received a full explanation as to why no measures will be taken to implement the recommendation;</li> <li>• we agree with the reasoning and/or we agree that we are unable to influence adoption of the recommendation; and</li> <li>• we have consulted RAIB on proposed non-implementation, in accordance with the Memorandum of Understanding.</li> </ul> <p>The ORR decision should clearly explain the reasons for this categorisation.</p>
<b>Other Public Body or Authority</b>	<p>The recommendation is also addressed to another public body or authority (as described in section 8).</p>
