Approval of the 21st supplemental agreement to the track access contract between Network Rail Infrastructure Limited and Abellio ScotRail Limited dated 3 March 2016

1. We have today approved the above supplemental agreement submitted to us formally on 27 April 2020 under section 22 of the Railways Act 1993 (the Act). This follows an earlier informal submission of a draft agreement for our consideration. This letter explains our decision.

2. The agreement extends contingent rights for services between Glasgow -Edinburgh and Edinburgh – Dunblane, which would otherwise expire on the Subsidiary Change Date 2020, for the remainder of Abellio ScotRail's track access contract. It also gives the operator calling rights at a new station in Kintore on the route between Inverurie and Aberdeen.

3. Network Rail undertook the usual industry consultation. No issues or concerns were raised by any of the consulted parties.

4. Our review of the application raised no operational, performance or economic concerns. We identified some minor drafting issues and these were resolved before the agreement was formally submitted.

5. We have concluded that approval of this supplemental agreement is consistent with our section 4 duties, in particular those relating to protecting the interests of users of railway services (section 4(1)(a)), promoting the use of the railway network for the carriage of passengers (section 4(1)(b)) and enabling persons providing railway services to plan their businesses with a reasonable degree of assurance (section 4(1)(g)).

6. Under clause 18.2.4 of the track access contract, Network Rail is required to produce a conformed copy, within 28 days of any amendment being made, and send copies to ORR and the Train Operator. Please send the conformed copy to me at ORR.

7. Electronic copies of this letter, the approval notice and the agreement will be sent to Keith Merritt at Department for Transport. Copies of the approval notice and the agreement will be placed on ORR's public register (website) and copies of this letter and the agreement will be placed on the ORR website.
